Tuesday April 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021 Meeting Minutes

**Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance recited.**

**Review of minutes** from the Tuesday March 9<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer,** gave overview of town's finances. 1 payment left on road repair.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor,** shared that there is an issue with the lock at the town garage and needs to be sealed. Was a septic issue at the town hall with a local resident flushing a diaper.

**Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor,** shared that the front tires were replaced on the mower tractor, service on the grader happened-removed plow wing and put stingers back on, graded Highland, Woodland and Colby but now roads are wet. Washout on Jack's Rd., but planned on replacing that culvert anyway this year.

**Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk,** had nothing to report

**Old Business: Cold Storage discussion-** Will put on next agenda and discuss again

**New Business:**

**Review bid for Norvado for internet for hall:** tabled for May agenda when new clerk takes over

**Room Tax discussion-** Mary McPhetridge from the Chamber came to discuss resigning a 5 year contract for room tax for the town of Eileen still with the stipulations of what we are currently doing along with the room tax percent being 6.5. The town board agreed so Mary will get updated contract sent over to Clerk.

**LRIP Terwilliger Rd Bids-** Only bid received from Northwoods Paving. Bid for \$38,505.53 for hot mix. Tony made motion to accept bid for LRIP project from Northwoods Paving, Skip seconded. Motion carried. Marty signed bid and handed to Scott from Northwoods Paving.

**Discussed New Ram Truck-** Town working with Bob D'Antonio at Red's Auto regarding 2016 Dodge Ram 3500 Dump Box. Cost is \$55,368.50. Truck is in good shape, can trade in the I-Ton. Tony made motion to officially sign purchase document for truck, Skip seconded. Board signed purchase agreement and clerk to write check to send.

**Discussed new Stimulus Money-** Stimulus money in the amount of \$68000 will come to the town in 2 payments- one for \$34000 this year and next year in May the same. Funds must be used for Covid related issues. Discussion of ventilation at garage, updating bathrooms.

**Conditional Use Permit for Petrichor Farms-** Board reviewed permit for living quarters above garage. Tony made motion to approve permit, Skip seconded. Board signed and Marty will run to county to drop off in AM.
