Meeting Minutes for Monday August 8, 2022

Review of minutes from the Tuesday June 14, 2022 regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, second by Marty Milanowski. Motion carried.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances \$45,648.49 in the checking account. \$19,174.57 in money market, \$40,515.02 in special project account, \$57,054.65 in ARPA checking account. Transferred \$500.00 from money market to a new business savings account which now has a balance of \$6,120.31. The business savings will be closed and put into the money market.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, updated report of the progress on the bathrooms was given by A to Z Plumbing. The fixtures will be touchless except for the toilets. Parts will be installed when everything arrives. Installation should be in the next couple of weeks. A problem with the water pressure in the kitchen will also be checked. Jerry Peterson will give a price on wallboard.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, Kathy Johanik reported on behalf of Tony. All roads are in good shape. Grass cutting along the roadsides is in the process. There is a need for some black dirt at the Town Hall in the rough areas of the lawn. A culvert will be replaced. Highland road needs bumps smoothed out.

Skip had received a call from a resident that said there is no stop sign on County Line and Woodland Road. Skip will check for the sign and have the area brushed back for better visibility.

Donna Anderson Office: Josh Huray will be the new agent for Rural Mutual Insurance. Norvado placed their equipment in the office for wifi set up.

Old Business: Chip seal will be placed on hold until next year. Reimbursement from the state for Carlson Road has not been paid out as of yet. Approximant dollar amount is around \$24,000.00. We will hold off on the new computers until a later date.
