**Carol Pufall**, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. \$103,420.47 is the balance in the checking account. Money Market \$25,333.87. Coronavirus Recovery Fund \$50,764.69.

**Skip Radosevich**, Town Supervisor; an update on the bathrooms was given. Floors and partitions should be in before Dawn Homish will paint. The floors will be in within the week. The fixtures have been ordered. Skip will check on the partitions.

They have moved into a renovated building for year round activities.

James Kmetz was questioned from a town resident about a town employee picking up garbage on private property. Supervisors and Chairman were not aware of the situation. This is not allowed. Proper procedure will be relayed to employees.
