**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer**, gave overview of town's finances. No outstanding checks. Town collected \$832,561.06 in taxes.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor**, shared that buildings are looking good, propane is filled, heaters all working well.

**Kathy Johanik gave overview of Tony's items**- Everything good on snow removal for the town, wing on Kelly truck getting repaired-just waiting on bracket, George is spray painting the rusty panels on the front end loader, and the guys trimmed trees on Kozeneski Rd due to hitting against school bus when bus goes down road.

**Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk**, shared there is an election on Feb 16<sup>th</sup>, testing machines on the 11<sup>th</sup>, received notice from Chicago Iron that we either need to pay for cylinders or return as they do not lease any longer, annual meeting reminder on April 20<sup>th</sup>.

**New Business:**

**Vince Kurta-Running for Bayfield County Circuit Court Judge**- Vince attended meeting and spoke about family, background that brought him to this point in life, and qualifications that allow him to run for this position. Vince is looking to make some changes in the current court and be fairer. Looking to have stricter and harsher punishments for sex crimes, child abuse, and overall child sex crimes. Vince thanked the board for allowing him to talk and will also be at the March meeting.

**Transfer of Liquor License from Quality Inn to Ashland Black Bears Inn LLC**- Discussed the room tax Quality Inn still owed. Clerk figured out that Quality Inn did for the most part pay us all but \$70. With that being said, Skip made motion to approve the transfer of liquor license to Ashland Black Bears Inn LLC, Marty seconded. Motion carried. Clerk and Chair signed license.
