**Meeting called to order at 6:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance recited.**

**Review of minutes** from the Tuesday May 10<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Marty Milanowski. Motion carried.

**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer**, gave overview of town's finances. \$20,159.13 in checking account, \$19,673.29 in money market, \$40,514.69 in special project account, \$20,839.33 in ARPA checking account. Transferred \$500 from money market to a new business savings account which now has a balance of \$5,610.26.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor**, Some progress was made on town hall bathrooms. Will talk with Jerry Peterson about stall walls. The new refrigerator is now at the hall. The hall internet was out, called centurylink for repair and they found that the line was cut when a different fiber optic cable line was installed.

**Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor**, Kathy Johanik reported on behalf of Tony. Radiator on Kelly truck was fixed with new radiator. New blades were added to the tractor brush mower. Hauled sand on various roads. Xcel will be supplying town with some gravel for road repairs caused by their trucks on Woodland Rd.

**Joe Mattson, Town Clerk**, Called to look into cost for new computer/printer for hall but waiting for response. The room tax for last year is now fully paid by Quality Inn. Expecting the first quarter check to show up soon. Expressed concern with town assessment and assessor not answering questions asked about possible discrepancies found while going through assessment role. Assessor not cooperative and unprofessional at times. Marty to ask assessor to get questions answered.
