Tuesday March 8th, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Review of minutes from the Tuesday February 8th regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion carried.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. \$74,200.13 in checking account, \$21,169.18 in money market, \$40,513.68 in special project account, \$22,839.33 in ARPA checking account. Transferred \$500 from money market to a new business savings account which now has a balance of \$4,080.13.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, Town hall bathrooms have been started but progress is still stalled waiting on fixture. AtoZ promised they would be operable by the April 5th election day. A garage door opener on the main garage building is not functioning and needs repair. Repair guy scheduled to come tomorrow to fix. Door handle on annex building broke. Skip took apart and is fixing. Mentioned new 17.5 cubic foot refrigerator quoted for town hall at 763.29.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, The bathroom at the garage has been cleaned up, painted and new shelving is installed for storage. The guys did a great job on it. Kelly truck had to have a radiator hose fixed. Had 3 loads of salt sand delivered. Guys are working on pushing the snow banks back. A new cutter edge for the 1-ton plow was purchased and installed. The plow shoes for the pay loader are being made.

Joe Mattson, Town Clerk, Reminder of the annual meeting coming up on April 19th at 5pm at the town hall and also the spring election on April 5th. Thanks to the guys for fixing the mailbox that was damaged with plow on the last snow storm. I was notified by the county that ballots were coming in later than normal but will still have plenty of time to send out absentee requested ones and get them back prior to the election.
