**Review of minutes** from the Tuesday April 13<sup>th</sup> regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion passed.

**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer**, gave overview of town's finances. 1 payment left on road repair. Grader payment due Feb.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor**, brought ideas for possible bathroom upgrades at the town hall. Mentioned propane tanks should be getting filled soon at the garage.

**Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor**, stated new culvert on Jacks Rd is now complete, mentioned the 9000 needs patchwork done on box & possibly new tires in future, talking with Scotts construction about cracking on Highland Rd needing possible crack seal, Terwilliger Rd work has started and needs new gravel base to remedy soft spots prior to blacktop, purchased a new riding lawnmower.

**Joe Mattson, Town Clerk**, mentioned we have received all our town documents from Haukaas Law to hold onto, asked if town mailbox could be upgraded to larger version, will be attending new election equipment demonstrations in August, insurance has been updated with new equipment, reminder for board of review is on Monday 5/17.

**Old Business:**

**Cold Storage discussion-** Tabled until prices come down

**Review Norvado Proposal-** Waiting on newest pricing, will add to next agenda after received.

**New Business:**

**Opening of Gravel Bids for #2 ¾”:** three bids were received and all had representatives at the meeting at time of opening. All bids were for gravel out of the Peterson Pit and with pricing available to town residents:

-Mika Construction & Transportation bid was \$18.50 per yard

-South Shore Sand & Gravel bid was \$20.09 per yard

-Ashland Construction bid was \$18.90 per yard

Motion to accept the bid from Mika Construction & Transportation for the bid of \$18.50 per yard was made by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Marty Milanowski. Motion passed.

**Review class A permit for Sheila Arganbright-** Permit reviewed with a motion to approve made by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion passed.

**Review Waste Management Agreement-** Update to the BASW Agreement reviewed with a motion to approve made by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed. Agreement signed by Marty Milanowski and Joe Mattson.

**Discussed Lindblad Rd Blacktop-** Residents of Lindblad Rd offered to pay half of the cost to blacktop the road if the town would be willing to pay the other half. Town board discussed and a motion was made by Skip Radosevich to pursue project offer, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion passed.

**Discuss Horse matter on town roads-** Town residents have complained about people riding horses on town roads (and tri-county corridor) and leaving the fecal matter in the middle of the road without cleaning up or moving to the side. Town discussed and will look into adding signage on town roads as necessary.

**Discuss comprehensive planning committee plans** – reviewed number of members and a committee meeting will be getting set up.

**Public Input:**

- Esther Arganbright asked if there were any rules against light pollution and if the town could look into if there could be something done to enforce it. Hard to see driving at night and light glaring in windows.
- Tom Beronich mentioned the shoulder on Colby Rd. by his mailbox is in need of repair.

**Motion to approve** and pay vouchers by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johnaik Motion passed.

**Motion to adjourn** meeting by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.
