Review of minutes from the Sept 9th regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. Sitting very well this time of year compared to last year.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, shared that he received a call from resident in regards to being on a dead end and having the garbage truck turn around in their driveway. Randy and Skip will go out and fix as it should actually have a turn around there. Skip also mentioned that he asked Zifko to fill up the town tanks.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that the V-plow is down and a great big thank you should be given to resident Jim Kmetz who helped with this. Tony shared that George was in the Highland rd area doing road side cutting, shared that the oil plan was replaced on the Kelly truck with a stainless steel one. Still need to put the 4 cables on the Kelly truck. Stated that culvert on Hnath was replaced hat had caved in, Pat McKuen added culverts on Highland Rd, town still has 1 culvert left on Jacks rd. Stated also that 14 loads of gravel had been hauled and the town was done with that. Tony also shared that Ben Dufford is looking for \$150 donation to CWD program the county is putting together for dumpsters. Board agreed on donation.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, shared that the WEC grant the town received was approved and signed off on that we used all of it in the correct manner.

Old Business:

Discussion of Highland Road- Marty stated he looked at the area near the ditch with Randy and they did not think the damage was bad. May do a little cold patching when the weather gets good again. Also looked at the culvert area where the road was heaving, and there is not a concern here.
