Tuesday September 13th Meeting Minutes

Review of minutes from the Tuesday August 8th regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Marty Milanowski. Motion carried.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. In checking account, **\$121,098.57**. The business savings was closed and put into the Money Market account. Balance of Money Market is **\$25,301.80**.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor,

Skip has contacted Dawn Homish to see about painting the bathrooms. Also would like to have the floors painted. She was out of town but Skip will get back to her in a couple days. A to Z Plumbing has not finished the plumbing for the bathrooms. Some work has been done but the men's bathroom need to be done.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, Kathy Johanik reported on behalf of Tony. The culvert on Colby Road has been replaced. Maintenance is being performed on the equipment on an as needed basis.

Donna Anderson Office . DOT correspondence for the work to be performed on Hwy 137. Received correspondence form the County that Haman Logging will be doing logging. Marty will check this out.

Received an e-mail from Lynn Devine on an update on our comprehensive plan. This will be looked into by Comprehensive plan members.

Old Business: None discussed.

New Business:

Snow plow rates were discussed. As per board agreement the rates from the previous year will apply to this year. ¼ mile or less at the rate of \$200.00 and over ¼ mile at \$250.00. November 15th is the deadline for applicants to contact the treasurer with an application and the proper funds. An ad will be placed in the Daily Press with the rates. Applications can be obtained on our web site and also at the posting box at the Town Garage.

Brush Mower:

A purchase of a new brush mower was discussed. The old mower is not being used at this time as without warning it jumps out of gear causing a safety risk. The purchase of a new mower, along with the trade in of the present brush mower and the 310 back hoe would bring the price down. An account of \$40,000.00 has been set aside for a new shed but with the trade in of the equipment used to purchase the brush mower a new building will not be needed. This \$40,000.00 can be allocated as a down payment on the new brush mower. The L9000 truck can also be sold and this money will be used to pay down the brush mower. The purchase of \$170,000 brush mower, with the trade in of the old mower, with a trade in value of \$27,500.00, will be for a term of rent for a 3 year period with Lulich Implement. Lulich Implement will carry the rental agreement. A motion was made to purchase a new brush mower through Lulich Implement by Skip Radosevich with a second by Marty Milanowski. Motion Carried.

Discussion of the hourly wage of the election workers. It was determined that the workers would receive an \$1.00 an hour raise giving the Chief election official \$14.00 per hour and the other elections workers \$13.00 per hour. A motion by Skip Radosevich to give the election workers a \$1.00 pay increase and a second by Marty Milanowski. The motion carried.

Public Input:

A town resident who has purchased property on the Zepcyk Road would like to have the road brought up to better condition. He has plans to build in a few years. This road has been closed off in the winter because it is not a traveled road but a farm road used between Franzel and Raspotnik. Marty and Skip will go and assess the road and see if gravel needs to be put in to help the condition of the road.

Motion to approve and pay vouchers by Skip Radosevich and a second by Marty Milanowski. Motion carried.

Motion to adjourn meeting by Skip Radosevich and second by Marty Milanowski. Motion carried. The Town Board meeting adjourned at 7:30 pm.
