Meeting Minutes

Started at 7:00PM @ Bayfield County Business Park

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Review of minutes from the August 12th, 2020 regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. Sitting very well this time of year compared to last year.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, shared that he fixed the faucet in women's bathroom at the hall, stated no problems at the garage, Randy getting prices for new torch kit at the garage.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that the Kelly truck is fixed, grader is back and all add-ons are taken care of, working on switching the v-plow right now, the guys are working on crack sealing the roads, Hnath and Jack's Rds need culverts and are being worked on, couple small culverts needed on Highland still, on Woodland road driveway culverts replaced but left standing water so town looking at prices to rent excavator to take care of.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, shared noted that the Lulich bill wasn't adjusted yet but Marty provided new bill to pay that showed correction. Had Marty sign 2 more copies of Pilsen agreement for Range Rd Maintenance so she can send to Pilsen clerk so we have original signatures for each town. Pilsen chair will also sign and Crystal to get a copy back from Pilsen Clerk. Clerk working with new business going into Link's smokehouse on liquor license paperwork. Need to be approved by the 15th of October so will have on the October 13th agenda. Insurance is now added on grader.

Old Business:

Discussion of Range Road- Town of Pilsen requested 2 separate checks from town. One for back-owed gravel and one for the 1/3rd prorated maintenance agreement. Clerk wrote both checks. Once town of Pilsen receives both, they will cut check owed to the town for culvert on Range.

New Business:-No bids received for Cold Housing Storage. Town tabled until next meeting.

Discussion of radio quotes for the trucks- Looking to seeing if Bayfield County will be willing to sell the radios in their trucks as they are looking at all new ones currently. Will wait to see if we can do this before proceeding with anything else.

Discussion of Special Use Application from Northern States Power. Got Tim Lisson, Principal Land Rights Agent on the phone to answer questions the board had. Will be Electric substation off of Terwilliger Rd. Skip made a motion to accept permit without any reservation, Marty seconded. Board signed permit and Marty dropping at Bayfield County tomorrow.

Discuss snow plow contract for the 2020-2021 year. No changes from last year. All contracts must be in by November 15th to avoid paying the extra fee. Clerk to type and get posted on site right away.

Discuss insurance on employee tools- Rural Mutual insurance will not cover if any employee tools get stolen or damaged. Randy looking into what it would cost with his insurance to cover extra on his tools. Board will consider paying the extra on his premium so he is covered. Waiting for Randy to get his quote back to town.

Public Input:

- Resident Troy Weber voiced his concerns of the damaged shoulders on Highland Rd where TDI construction caused cracking of the black top. Concern of this worsening and asked the town to do something. Marty will stop to talk to the TDI guys who are currently working on 137 to discuss how they can fix.

Troy also mentioned a culvert on Highland pushing up through the black top. Marty will have the town crew look at this as well.

Motion to approve and pay vouchers by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion passed.

Motion to adjourn meeting by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.
