Review of minutes from the March 12th board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, was absent-clerk read report for treasurer

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, had nothing to report.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that the 1 Ton repairs have now been finished. The L9000 sander is currently getting repaired.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, stated that FEMA is still requesting information and that she is providing as needed. 4 of the 5 projects are completed by FEMA. Finishing up Colby and Gilles projects yet with the paperwork side of things. Clerk reminded the board of annual meeting on Tuesday April 16th. Clerk shared that she received letter from Dept of Rev stating we didn't file the town's W7's. Clerk did file them and resent but wondered if we should pay bill received for estimated owing to the State. Board said to just pay since we will get reimbursed. Clerk verified dates of BOR which open book is May 10th from 4:30-6:30 and BOR is May 21st from 6-8. Also discussed SAM renewal. Board approved renewing the \$499 subscription until we know everything is settled with FEMA and the state.
