Review of minutes from the July 9th, board meeting and July 11th special meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, was absent so Clerk read report on her behalf. Clerk cautioned the board to look at checks tonight to see what should be held as we have only a little over \$33,000 in the bank and the bills add up to close to \$80,000 tonight.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, shared that Quality Tree Service sent him a bill by email and he put it on clerk's desk. Clerk did write a check for it tonight in the bills that are being approved.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor shared that the AC is leaking on the mower tractor and was at Don's for repair. Also shared that all gravel has been hauled to all of the roads from South Shore.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, shared that she has signed off on 3 more projects in the Grants Portal and the 3 projects total reimbursement of \$225, 625.98. Last time she signed off on a project the town received a check within a month. The town is hoping for the same this time. Clerk also shared that the town now holds an account at L&M.
