Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, gave overview that tires on the new truck are being fixed, new parts and new heater motor on new truck, straps and chains busted, new wedges spacers and new tires on equipment. Setzke Rd is finally plowed out and Heglund Rd is still needed to be done.

**New Business:**
