Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance recited.

Review of minutes from the January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 regular meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Marty Milanowski. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, shared that the town annex building had door issues. Skip took the door apart and fixed and lubed. Stated new lock on town garage is still good although still needs a bead of silicone placed. Randy is going to do that. Also shared that there is black mold in bathroom and office at town garage. Cautioned the guys not to clean or scrape without wearing masks. Looking into having someone come in to fix. Stated the guys are having issues replacing the cables on the Kelly truck. Skip will check back with Randy to see how it is going.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, added that he told the guys to leave the cables alone until spring on the Kelly truck and that for now just fill with fluids. Stated that the grader had a flywheel replaced along with starter and hydraulic ramp for wing.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, stated that we have 5 elections coming up and will have to change some town meeting dates due to this through the year. Also stated that election testing of machines will happen on February 15, 2020.

New Business:

- Dead end road discussion-Skip stated there are 41 dead end roads in the town. Marty stated they will look at maybe adding some turnarounds this year but will determine when they do road inspection.

- **2020 Projects**-Board discussed possibility of blacktopping Eileen Hall Rd, Culvert on Curry Rd, Work on Sickich, Carlson and Nemec Rd also.
- **WITC**-Clerk shared WITC has board openings if anyone is interested.
- **Town of Pilsen meeting discussiong**-Crystal and Tony shared that they attended the Town of Pilsen board meeting in January. Key items discussed:
  - -Town still owes Pilsen funds for gravel totaling 684.41. Pilsen decided that due to them owing the town for the work on Range Rd, they will not pay the town until the rest of the year is completed. They will then subtract off everything the town of Eileen owes and send the remainder of payment.
  - Discussion of the two towns setting up meeting to get together to discuss Range Rd and who pays for what. Clerks Suzi Misun and Crystal Mattson will talk as May gets closer to set a special meeting date that will work for both towns.
