July 10th Board Meeting

Meeting Minutes

7:00 pm @ Bayfield County Business Park

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance not recited as it had just been recited at the elector meeting beforehand.

Review of minutes from the June 19th board meeting and the June 19th special meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, absent so Crystal Mattson gave treasurer report on behalf of her. Board had no questions.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, had nothing to report.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that all paperwork is now submitted for FEMA and we should hear an answer on Wednesday July 12th. Tony gave brief overview about work that needs to be completed- the town has 11 culverts to replace, has 11 washouts. Some of the culverts need to be upsized so waiting on approval from FEMA for that. South shore will begin with hauling and placing some gravel next week.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, confirmed that she has been working on the paperwork with Tony for FEMA and that everything is submitted through date of what needs to be completed.

Old Business:

- **Road repairs from storm-**Marty reiterated that paperwork is in progress and that repairs and estimates alone are around \$193,000 for the town. This does not include the road crew and their work or the truck hours.

New Business:

- **Approve Liquor Licenses for Links and Lake Rock Cafe**-Tony made motion to approve the liquor license for Link's Smokehouse along with the liquor license for Lake Rock Café, Skip seconded. Motion passed.
- **Town picnic** tentatively set for either September 8th or September 9th.
- **Discussion of Xcel Energy Bill**- The board invited Greg Martinsen to the meeting to discuss the multiple bills the town is receiving from Xcel. After discussion, Marty and Greg narrowed down that the extra bill may be coming from the Co-op. Marty to call Tim Mika to discuss who is in charge of the co-op now and will add to next agenda.

Public Input:- Mark Mackey gave feedback regarding Road Superintendent pay and questioned if he was being treated fairly. Clerk mentioned that the board cannot discuss road superintended pay as it is not the public that sets the pay but the board. Clerk mentioned that everything is well documented in the case of the road superintendent. Board agreed.

Motion to approve and pay voucher #'s 10262-10288 by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.
