**Review of minutes** from the June 9th board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

**Carol Pufall, Treasurer**, gave report of balances and future deposits. Carol let town residents know that they can contact her any time with questions.

## **Old Business:**

- **Fire/Ambulance Update-** Marty and Wayne have been in contact with each other and discussing what to do between the towns. There is not a consistent message on what any of the towns are wanting so Marty was asked to contact the townships and try to collaborate to obtain a consistent message. If they can get 5 to 7 people to volunteer for the fire department, then the town of Mason would actually consider fire service.
- **Dust control on gravel roads-** The board made the decision to table this once again until they get final costs on all the gravel that is being placed throughout the town and any other repairs/maintenance that is going on.
- **Town Hall update-** Per Marty, the board is still getting mixed signals on what is happening. As of this time, they are still in negotiations and have more meetings scheduled.
- **Liquor licenses-** Licenses were approved and filed with the state for Sports Hollow, Lake Rock Cafe, and Link's Smokehouse.
- **Town Picnic-** Being held on August 16th. Clerk will post in the newspaper.

**New Business:**

- **Gravel Placement** – Per Marty, there are about 1-2 days left of gravel placement throughout the town. A couple of loads have been stockpiled just in case.
- **Town Crew duties**- The board decided that the town crew needs to use the daily spreadsheet for keeping track of what is being done and how long. The board also made the decision that we would be having a special meeting on Thursday, July 16th this week. The clerk will post appropriately.
- **Woodland Road**- Marty gave overview of the culvert project going on with Woodland Road. The only thing the town paid for was the culvert itself. To do the excavating, the board decided they would use K&D Excavating.
- **Propane Fill** – The board made the decision that we will go with Zifkos for our fill.
- **Snow Plowing** to be added to next agenda per Marty.

**Public Input:**

- **Joe Sajdak** stated that he is concerned with ruts in Sajdak Rd being left by garbage trucks. There are 2 residents that get a pick up on 2 separate days. He asked if someone can contact them. Joe also stated that he is concerned with the fact that there is not a stop sign at the Visitor Center. He suggests someone talks to the county regarding this.
- **Rodney Dymesich** stated he is concerned with the loads and damage that will happen on Curry Road with the CAFO farm.
- **Jim Kmetz** is concerned with the inconsistent mowing going on along the roads. He would like every resident treated equally when it comes to the town crew mowing certain areas over others.
