Emergency Special Meeting Minutes

8:30 PM @ Bayfield County Business Park

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance not recited as it had just been recited at the regular town board meeting beforehand.

Meeting started with public input regarding damage throughout the town from recent rain storm.

Jim Zorn, located on Colby Rd in our township, stated that at his property water came down the driveway and blocked 2 culverts. He stated he has some pictures of damage by his place and offered to send those pictures also to the clerk for added documentation of damage in the town. Tony Johanik stated he would be speaking to Ben Dufford at Bayfield County and would run him by Jim's property and would keep in contact with Jim.

Marty Milanowski gave rundown of the major damage in the town:

-1st road that will be concentrated on is Nemec road due to a resident being stuck at his property. Will remove current culvert (try to save it if possible) and replace with a new one.

-2nd road will be Franzel Rd. This road will need an 8 foot culvert instead of the previous 6.

-3rd Rd will be Colby. Colby road is currently passable but the town will be looking to add an overflow.

There are some wash outs throughout the town also including Karaba and South Range Rd.

The board discussed and reviewed the Emergency Proclamation Resolution typed up by the town clerk. After changing the storm damage dates, the board voted by way of verbal YES or NO. The result was 3 YES-0 NO to approve the resolution. Resolution passed.

Public Input:- No further input from residents.

Motion to adjourn meeting by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.
