Meeting Minutes

Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance not recited as it had just been recited at the elector meeting beforehand.

Review of minutes from the February 14th, 2019 board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. Also discussed that the line of credit is almost completed. Carol also shared a thank you to the board for a gift card that was sent to retired poll worker Shirley Tarasewicz.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, had nothing to report.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that work is being done on the L900 (the UJoint) and Bob Koval is doing engine work on the Work Star. Tony reminded the board that the Highland project needs to be completed by June 30th. Marty stated he would call Scott with Scott Construction. Tony also made clerk aware that road limits will need to be posted in the next week coming up. Just waiting on when county is posting.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, shared that our new FEMA rep is requesting more paperwork per meeting the board had on 3/9/19. Reminded the board and residents of upcoming election on April 2nd, the Annual meeting on April 16th. Clerk also requested the board to reimburse for newspaper subscription. The only reason she gets the paper is to watch for postings. The board agreed and approved.

Old Business:

- **Xcel Energy response-** Received response from Xcel Energy that if they shut down meter # 4499353 it will also shut down the town hall meter as they are tied together. Board determined that we will just bill the co-op monthly for the meter.

New Business:

- Gary Johanik from the Town of Pilsen discussed bills that the Town of Eileen still owes. Referenced work completed on North Range Rd and the town shares the bill with the Town of Pilsen. Tony shared that our total of billing for South Range and damage from last year's storm totals over \$5000. Gary determined that he would take those numbers back to his board before a decision is made. The Town of Pilsen will be billing us for sure for plowing as that was agreed on before winter season. The board agreed with Gary. Gary also wanted to confirm that the Town of Eileen will be sharing the cost for culvert replacement and work on Range rd as previously agreed upon. Board confirmed.
- **Discussion of purchasing plow Truck-**Tony requested the town thinking about having another truck on hand. There is a local town trading a truck in that is in decent shape so he wanted the board to just be thinking of this.
- **Discussion of residents requesting driveways to be winged and plowed and don't have contracts-** Board all decided that we will not provide this service to anyone without a contract this year. There are other companies who can provide these services.
- **Time clock discussion-** Tony shared with the board that he would like the town crew to punch in and out for each job they do so they can better track time of wear the town employees are. The board agreed and Tony will share with the road crew.
- **New commercial electrical rules-** Marty reviewed the form received from the state that towns may exercise rights to get involved when certain commercial properties are running electrical through the buildings.
- **Bill from Century Link for wire damage from 8/1/18-** The town received a bill from Century link along with a letter regarding a Tort claim has been filed against the town regarding line damage on Schutte Rd. Diggers hot line marked spots and did miss one where the town crew was digging. After confirmation previously, Century Link should not have had a line ran in that area. Marty will be looking into the claim further and the board agreed they would get Craig Haukus involved if necessary.

Public Input:- Shannon Schneeberger asked if Marty knew when a line from Century Link might be run down Highland-it had previously been noted it was going to be April of this year. Marty told Shannon he would call her after speaking with Mark Abels Allison at the county.

Motion to approve and pay bills by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.
