Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Marty Milanowski, Chairperson. Pledge of Allegiance not recited as it had just been recited at the elector meeting beforehand.

Review of minutes from the February 13th board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer, gave overview of town's finances. Carol shared that the next large deposit the town will be receiving will be from transportation aide.

Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor, shared that he is still following up on the issue with the town's Xcel Energy bills.

Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor, shared that the hydraulic hose was replaced on the L-9000. Also shared that the welding on the 1-ton has been completed. Tony gave an overview of the meeting he attended that was held by Bayfield County on 3/7/18. Regarding the industrial park: 5 bids had been submitted to the county regarding building the new road from State Farm Road midway down through the industrial park area. Nels Ritola ended up winning the bid at \$246000. The county is planning the road in 2 segments. The first will cost the county \$450000 to do the road toward the new KV Tech location. They county is paying for this work and looking for grants. The second part the county is first looking to sell off 5 to 10 acres from State Park Rd to the KV Tech site so that they can pay the rest of the road to be completed. After road is completed the county wants the town to maintain.

Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk, reminded the board we have our annual meeting in April also. She will also be signing the guys up for MSHA training in Mellen in May. She got the approval to write a check outside of a meeting approval.

New Business:

- **Marty shared some information** from a meeting he went to for the WI DOT. North of the roundabout at the HWY 13 intersection, the WI DOT is looking to replace culverts. They can do this over a 3-4 day period if the town will allow them to re-route traffic down Terwilliger Rd. If the town does not allow this, it will cost them \$150,000 to build a new road around the area where they are replacing culverts. Marty stated there will be more to come on this.
- **Marty also shared** that on March 21st, he will be attending a meeting in Bayfield County regarding a roundtable discussion with other area officials on crime in the county.
