- **Naming the town hall entrance/road-**It was mentioned by the road superintendent that he was notified that we need to name the entrance to the town hall due to applying for separate fire numbers for the surrounding buildings. The clerk will look into this process.
- **Forestry Northern Headquarters-**The state DNR has issued a memo that they are looking to build a Forestry Headquarters in Northern Wisconsin. If interested, the town can come up with

a resolution to have it be built here. Marty will follow up with Mark Abels-Allison for more information.

- **Century Link Meeting-** On May 23rd at 7:00 pm, all residents are welcome to attend the Town Meeting at the Pilsen Town hall where Mark Scribner, supervisor for Century Link will be discussing and answering questions on the CAF funding that they received.
