Review of minutes from September 13<sup>th</sup> Board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

## Old Business:

- **Fire/Ambulance Update-** Marty shared that the Town of Eileen has now signed the contract with the City of Ashland for 10 years with a 1.5% increase each year.
- **Historical Society Flagpole-** Marty asked Joe Sajdak if he has any information yet on the flagpoles and he said he is still waiting on this.
- **Truck Update-** Tony gave update on the 1-Ton : Getting new universal joints, looking for fuel tank. The box will be in next week sometime and sent to Marshfield. When it is received Al Zifko will be doing the work to replace it.

## New Business:

- **Deed for town hall-** Marty shared that we now have the official deed for the town hall.
- **Grant request for surrounding towns-** Marty stated that some surrounding areas have been granted funds from the storm damage. The town of Eileen has not had much damage.
- **Meeting November 9<sup>th</sup>** – There is a comprehensive planning, zoning, and decision making standard meeting to be held on this date. The board was given the information and will decide who will attend.
- **Road Operator-** We have received 4 applications now for the road operator position and will be in contact with the individuals to do interviews soon.

- **Town Meeting Rescheduled November-** The November town meeting will be rescheduled to Tuesday November 15<sup>th</sup> due to election. The clerk will post in the paper.

**Public Input:**

- **Kevin Tamke** wanted to get on record the article in the paper on Thursday of last week regarding the residents of Ashland County suing Ashland county for being overtaxed. Kevin stated this may affect the town of Eileen also and that we may be able to get in on the lawsuit. Marty thanked Kevin for bringing this to the attention of the board and town residents in attendance.
- **Geoge Setzke** was wondering if we are still working on getting the water and sewage bills split now that we are in the building. Marty stated that we just recently received the deed so we can now look into this further.
- **Dan Green** asked if there was any way to get some gravel on Hegstrom Road. The opposite end has had some but he has some mud pits that he would like filled in. Marty stated we would keep doing what we can, however we have put down \$38,000 in gravel so far.
