**Review of minutes** from the September 11th board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer**, gave treasurer report. We will get in large deposit of transportation aid yet this year. MM was closed per last meeting instructions of board. Carol gave board information on loan rates in case they need to do anything for funding with our town road work. Northern State Bank is the best rate so far for \$50,000 line at 3.25%. Waiting to hear back from Chippewa Valley.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor**, stated that 6 outlets in the town hall have been replaced and upgraded to 30 amp. He also shared that he replaced the mercury light in the town garage over the timeclock. Skip stated that there is no longer an issue with the town garage door and that it was just a switch that kept getting stuck. Skip made the suggestion that the next work that gets completed in the town hall is the bathrooms.

**Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor**, shared that the Moore tractor work is completed and that currently the backhoe tractor is down. He made note that we have enough salt/sand for the rest of the 2018 year and maybe only need a load. Discussed just getting it from South Shore and no bid to be placed. Also asked the board what they thought about South Range road for plowing. Will residents go with Pilsen or with us? Tony to call Bob with the Town of Pilsen to discuss.

**Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk**, shared that we met with our FEMA rep Ralph Chambers last week on Friday and that he was very impressed with everything we have done so far. The town has 60 days from October 5<sup>th</sup> to identify any damage and that the town has 18 months to complete the work. Shared with the FEMA rep that we should be done within 2-3 weeks. The FEMA rep was very impressed with everything that has been completed and with the paperwork that was given during the meeting.

**Old Business:**

- **Progress of Road repairs from storm-** There are 10 roads left which should be completed within 2-3 weeks.

**New Business:**

- **Conditional Class A permit-** Board reviewed permit for Darlene Blomquist to demo current home and build a new home on AG-1 land. Skip Radosevich made a motion to approve the permit, Tony Johanik seconded. Motion carried. Marty to bring signed permit to Bayfield County in the AM.
- **Conditional Class A permit-** Board reviewed permit for Don Lulich to build 2 storage buildings in the town of Eileen. Tony made a motion to approve the permit, Skip seconded. Motion carried. Marty to bring signed permit to Bayfield County in the AM.
- **Snowplowing contract-** The board agreed that no changes would be made to the snowplow contract from the 2017-18 season and would remain the same for the 2018-19 season.
