**Review of minutes** from the August 7th board meeting. Motion to accept minutes as read by Tony Johanik, seconded by Skip Radosevich. Motion passed.

**Carol Pufall, Town Treasurer**, gave treasurer report. We will get in large deposit of transportation aid yet this year. Discussed closing out MM to pay for large road work bills. Board agreed.

**Skip Radosevich, Town Supervisor**, had nothing to report

**Tony Johanik, Town Supervisor**, shared that there is an issue with the tractor currently overheating. Also shared that on Woodland road there are some kids building a bridge which is nice, but a culvert is needed. Tony to speak with the resident. If nothing happens the town will send a letter that they will remove and require the resident to do a culvert.

**Crystal Mattson, Town Clerk**, shared that to date we have paid out \$108,805.43 for road repairs. Asked the board to follow up with Randy and let him know that she needs from 8/15/18-current of his personal work with the roads so she can input into FEMA spreadsheets. Reminded Tony to call on 3 bids yet for the road repairs. At last FEMA meeting clerk and Tony went to they were told to just call and get 3 bids regarding road work. Asked the board what to do with culvert permits and they said to just hold onto them.

**Old Business:**

- **Progress of Road repairs from storm-Highland** has had 460 yds down with road reground. Completed culverts are Franzel, West Woodland, Schutte, Karaba Driveay, Range road by corridor. Up next will be Nemec, N Colby and N Gilles. After that will be Zepczyk, Hillsdale, Sutarik and new washout on Chapek.

**New Business:**

- **Conditional Class A permit-** Board reviewed permit for Jeff Buechner to build a home on AG-1 land. Skip Radosevich made a motion to approve the permit, Tony Johanik seconded. Motion carried. Marty to bring signed permit to Bayfield County in the AM.
- **Century Link Claim-** Marty shared that the town hit a line on Whipperfurth and Schutte Rd and after talking to Century Link, sounds like nothing will need to be done.
- **Karaba Rd Culvert-** Tony discussed the fact that the town replaced a culvert on a driveway on Karaba Rd and also paid for gravel to be put down. The town tried to take the old culvert but the resident got upset and threatened to call the police. The board agreed that they would bill the resident for the new culvert then and the gravel since he wouldn't let the town take the old culvert. There is a possibility of the bill being added to the tax bill if it is not paid. It needs to be decided by Nov 4<sup>th</sup> for the Treasurer to add to the tax bill.
- **Donation to Douglas County-**Regarding Superior Days-the town board agreed to make donation of \$100. Motion was made by Tony Johanik for approval and Skip Radosevich seconded. Motion carried.
- **October agenda-**Clerk to add snowplowing to October agenda.

**Public Input:-** Anne Wickman shared that the Visitor center would be holding an event on Saturday September 29<sup>th</sup> from 8:30-9.

**Shannon Schneeberger** shared that if you go out to Norvado's website you can click and pick a link to "get fiber". She is trying to rally individuals to push to get more service in the area.

**Motion to approve** and pay voucher #'s 10319-10358 by Skip Radosevich, seconded by Tony Johanik. Motion passed.
